Congregational Meeting

The session is calling for a quorum of the Shawnee RP congregation to meet on Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at 7 p.m. This brief meeting is to be held prior to our regular prayer meeting.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss with the congregation the session's intent to offer Mr. Andrew Battiato an internship starting July 1, 2019 which pending decisions by RPGM, could last between eight (8) to twelve (12) months. We plan to ask the congregation to voice their support.

As the congregation knows, we had planned for a summer intern from our church's seminary in this year's budget. However, we learned of Andrew's longer-term availability after the budget was formed. The session believes offering this internship would be a wise investment in the kingdom of God and mutually beneficial for Shawnee and the Battiato's. We are thankful to God the church is financially able to offer this internship, the details of which will be presented at our meeting.
