Shawnee RPC Edict Notice of a Congregational Meeting to Elect Ruling Elders:

The Session having decided to conduct an election for up to three ruling elders, the congregation is called to meet on the 24th day of March in the year 2021, 7:00 p.m. at the church. Members unable to be present may participate by absentee vote or by virtual vote, written guidelines for which are provided in the weekly bulletin. Given this 10th day of March in the year 2021, by order of the Session.

Voting guidelines for communicant members unable to attend the meeting:

1. Absentee voting: Absentee votes may be sent prior to the meeting in writing, addressed to the session and enclosed in a sealed envelope which bear the voter's name. Absentee votes are valid only on the first electing ballot.
2. Virtual voting: Members voting virtually must watch the livestreaming of the election meeting. These votes will be texted to Elder Ron Patterson @ 913-624-4469 at the time(s) in the meeting when members are asked to complete their ballots. It is the responsibility of the member to send their text at the appropriate time as observed on the livestream. Upon receipt, Elder Patterson will write the names texted on a paper ballot and when the texter's name is read by the moderator, Elder Patterson will cast the vote on behalf of the texter. Only Elder Patterson will know how the texter voted and will never reveal that vote to others. If the texter wishes to have their vote texted to another elder, that can be arranged. Note this important pre-requisite: Anyone wishing to vote in this manner must send a test text message to Elder Patterson prior to Wednesday, March 24th. A private livestream link will be sent via email to those voting in this manner.

Building Use: In light of current efforts to decrease the spread of Covid-19, and in efforts to protect our church members, leadership, and especially those who are at high risk, we request that building use be limited to critical needs. Church leaders and members should not be at the church building unless there is a specific need to be there (e.g. livestreaming worship, mowing, building maintenance). Members needing access to the building should make a request to the Deacon Board by emailing deaconboard@shawneerpc.org. We feel this is a needed measure to ensure we are doing our part to limit the spread of this virus and protect those who are at risk.

Tithing: This is an important aspect of our Christian life and we want to provide multiple ways for members to contribute while we are not meeting in person. Offerings can be made by one of the following mechanisms:

- 2) Online bill-pay through your own banking institution - members can set up on their own using the church name as the payee, and Barry VanHorn’s address for check delivery location.
- 3) Mobile Giving through Tithe.ly – www.shawneerpc.org/give/ - this option allows you to pay with a Debit/Credit card info or with your Bank info.
