DEACON REMINDERS - December 2021

- A lot has happened in the past two years, and the deacon board has talked a lot about God's goodness to our congregation during this time. We should all reflect on God's gracious provision to the church.
- "Back to normal:" - worship services, Sabbath school, activities, fellowship dinners, *etc.*
- New pastors
- Growth / attendance - possible building project in the near future...
- Reminders - stewardship of what God has given us, courtesy and care for one another, safety, *etc.*

Grounds: (Outside)

- Parking lot lighting: Even though the parking lot has much better lighting, reminder to all kids to refrain from playing in or near the parking lot: there are plenty of other places to play!
- Hallway door to the courtyard sticks - Please check, especially if used during the week.
- Weather: With wet or snowy weather comes mud. Mud belongs outside, not inside. Please help us try to keep the mud outside

Grounds: (Inside)

- **Sound booth / Technology equipment:**
Tech committee has done a terrific job improving the church's technology. This means we have expensive equipment in the church, so a reminder than only those authorized by the Tech committee should be touching the equipment (sound booth, computers, TV's, speakers, microphones, *etc.*).
- **Nursery:**
 - The nursery committee has asked that only nursery workers and parents of nursery-age children (up to 2 yrs old) be in the nursery between Sabbath school and services.

- Please help the committee by keeping children over the age of 2 out of the nursery, especially after services, as nursery workers clean-up/sanitize at this time.

- **Sanctuary:**

- The sanctuary fills up as the Lord continues to bless us with more people attending services, especially in the back. We ask people to consider moving up to leave the back pews for those who might arrive late.
- Please take a moment, especially following the PM service, to tidy up around seating areas.

- **General / Misc:**

- Fellowship hall/meals: Instant Pots are a big draw on our electrical circuits, so ideally these should be plugged in on separate circuits to avoid tripping breakers. Feel free to ask a deacon if you have questions on where to plug these in.
- Children, please do not use the kitchen door to reach the playground. Children are not to be in the kitchen without a supervising adult.
- Wheelchairs: The church has two wheelchairs available to any who might need them. If you don't need a wheelchair, don't use a wheelchair. We need them in good working order for when they are needed.
- Parents remind children, (and children remind parents,) no running inside the building.

Please help us keep the building clean, (kitchen, classrooms, *etc.*) especially related to food. Anything not picked up on Sabbath will likely sit all week until our custodians clean the building. We're currently winning the battle against the ants and other bugs, but when food gets left out it doesn't take them long to find it. The deacons would also appreciate it if you could put loose trash (especially food) in the bagged trash cans rather than the outside trash carts to prevent things from sticking to the bottom.

Tithing: This is an important aspect of our Christian life, and we want to provide multiple ways for members to contribute. Offerings are collected as part of our morning worship service, or can also be made by one of the following mechanisms: 1) Mail a check – For security reasons please make checks payable to “The Reformed Presbyterian Church of Shawnee” and mail your check to: Matt Boyle, Deacon Chair (see directory for Matt's address) 2) Online bill-pay through your own banking institution - members can set up on their own using the church name as the payee, and Matt Boyle's address for check delivery location. 3) Mobile Giving through Tithe.ly – www.shawneerpc.org/give/ - this option allows you to pay with a Debit/Credit card info or with your Bank info. .
