How Will We Baptize the Nations?

Matthew 28:18-20 calls us to go and make disciples of all nations by two primary activities: baptizing and teaching. For many American Christians, our efforts are largely in the second category. This is because we live in a largely “baptized” nation, in that many people, believers and unbelievers, have some sort of church background. Much of our outreach to our fellow citizens is “reclamation” work to baptized but wandering sheep who need to be taught to obey all that Christ has commanded. This is good and right for us to do. But beyond our own children, how will we also give attention to the command to baptize? Where do we go to reach those who have no church background, who do not know Jesus’ name at all, except perhaps as a casual curse word that they hear from time to time?

One answer is found in communities of internationals who live in America. These groups are often made up almost entirely of the unbaptized. We can obey Jesus’ command by going to them.

To help us, Vince Ward and RPGM have launched the Ambassadors for Christ initiative. This eight-month training program will run from September to April this coming year. Reaching internationals with the gospel is not easy, and Ambassadors for Christ is not a light commitment. Participants will have weekly requirements, accountability, training, homework, and much practical application.

Do you think God may be calling you to participate in this ministry? All participants must be approved by the session. Perhaps this is one way that God might use some of us to reach the nations!
